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Paper Airplane Folding Instructions

To fold the paper airplane follow the numbers start with fold 1 and work your way up through the numbers.

When there are two of the same numbers either can be folded first but the second fold should be made so that it is symmetric (mirrors) the first. Usually this is an attempt to make the left and right side identical to each other.

Crease: Will usually have two numbers. On the first number fold the paper along this line so that the line can be seen (line is on the outside of the fold) then unfold it to leave the paper creased. On the second number fold it again and leave it folded.

Reverse Crease: Follows the same rules as a crease except that the fold is made so that the line is hidden by the fold. (line is on the inside of the fold)

Fold: Fold the paper along this line so that the line can be seen. (line is on the outside of the fold)

Reverse Fold: Fold the paper along this line so that the line is hidden by the fold. (line is on the inside of the fold)

Cut: Use a pair of scissors to cut the paper along this line

Make sure that your printer is set to full scale measure one of these lines it should be exactly 3 centimeters or 1 inch, as shown on the line. If the line is not exactly the dimension shown you will need to adjust your printer settings.

The exact printer field to be adjusted may vary with printer, mine uses the terms actual size also setting the custom size to 100% will have the same result.
